DENNIS WALKER'S TRACTOR HAS A HOME AT NLAGARA ANTIQUE POWER

Dennis bought the tractor from a farmer in St Catharines, Ontario. He purchased the front-end loader that was originally from that tractor from another farmer in the Niagara area. Dennis did a lot of restoration work to the tractor and added a quick connect attachment for the loader and also added forks. He did a lot of upgrades to the tractor to make it more reliable. Dennis bought the tractor to help with the moving around of his huge collection. Now N.A.P.A. has a tractor of their own with the equipment needed to do a lot of the work around the show grounds without having to always borrow or rent one. This will make their jobs much easier. This Ford tractor will always remind us of Dennis, a founding member who once owned it.
