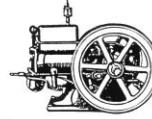

ALL TSSA LICENCED OWNER/OPERATORS when registering your steam operated equipment “PLEASE MAKE SURE” you have a photo copy of all your “REQUIRED CERTIFICATIONS”. We “MUST ALSO SEE” a document proving that you have the **TWO MILLION IN LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE** that is required to display your equipment on our grounds. Without the proper paperwork and under the stipulations of our insurance you will not be allowed to participate at our show. Due to the privacy protection act we cannot insist a photo copy of your insurance coverage be provided, however it would be greatly appreciated to add with your other documentations. All documents collected will be stapled to your registration forms and kept private for our records only. On behalf of N.A.P.A we wish to thank all TSSA members in advance for your co-operation in this matter.

PLEASE NOTE: THE TWO MILLION LIABILITY INSURANCE IS FOR LARGE STEAM ENGINES ONLY
